What's in this kit

Thank you for choosing 50 & Fabulous for someone wonderful. This little kit is my gift to you — a handful of printables that turn the book into a whole celebration. Print the pages you like, and make her fiftieth one she'll never forget.

Inside you'll find:

1. A keepsake bookplate to tuck inside the front of the book, so she always knows who it came from.
2. 50 Reasons You're Fabulous — a fill-in list where you (or everyone at the party) write the reasons she's loved.
3. A 50th birthday toast builder — a simple fill-in-the-blanks template so your toast lands every time.
4. How Well Do We Know the Birthday Girl? — a warm, funny party game to play together.
5. Printable party signs — a "50 & Fabulous" table card and a mini banner.

Nothing here needs an app, a login, or a single ounce of craftiness. Print, write, and celebrate.

A little reminder: the book itself holds 200 warm and funny notes across 8 chapters. This kit is the extra touch around it — the wrapping, the party, and the personal words only you can add.

Fold this in half so it stands on its own:

Mini banner

Print one letter per page (landscape works nicely), punch two holes at the top of each, and thread ribbon or string through to hang your banner:

F · A · B · U · L · O · U · S · A · T · 5 · 0

Tip: no time to cut letters? Just print the table card twice as big and tape it to the wall. Done is better than perfect, and she'll love it either way.
